YALI Regional Leadership Center East Africa (YALI RLC-EA) is supported by United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and implemented by Kenyatta University. The programme has successfully trained over 5,300 young African leaders from 14 countries in East and Central Africa since 2015.

The Trevor Noah Foundation (TNF), supported by the Oak Foundation, is dedicated to equipping underserved youth in Africa with the necessary educational foundation and opportunities to become resilient future leaders. TNF's interventions focus on learner skills development, teacher training and support, and infrastructure improvement to ensure young people have viable learning options postmatric.
